OTHER INFORMATION	<p>The can states that it contains: <i>Double 500ml plastic blood-pack collection units – 15 ga. needle with ACD anticoagulant Citrate Dextrose Solution Formula A.</i> <i>Each unit consists of a primary pack containing 75 ml of ACD anticoagulant containing 2.24% Dextrose B.P., 2.20% Sodium citrate B.P., 0.8% Citric Acid B.P., in Water for Injections B.P., for collection of not more than 500ml of blood; plus one 400 ml. capacity Transfer Pack without anticoagulant.</i> <i>Sterile, nonpyrogenic fluid path</i> <i>FENWAL DIVISION BAXTER LABORATORIES LIMITED, Thetford, Norfolk, England.
