Steven Pierce is the author of an excellent review of prominent people associated with blood groups serology in the US<sup>1</sup>. He is also co-author of a major text book<sup>2</sup> that includes details of many of the people who have been important in setting up blood banking organisations and working in blood transfusion, especially in the US. Whilst this historical review concentrates on the discovery of the blood groups and the technical aspects of blood grouping, the book also concentrates on the people involved, providing separate biographies within the text.
