

ITEM / TITLE	EIGHT DIFFERENT COLOURED ABO / RH TYPE BLOOD GROUP LABELS – WITH BAR CODES
PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION	Coloured bar coded blood group labels (approx 4.25 x 2.75 inches) for labelling blood donations – group O blue; group A yellow; group B pink and group AB white with black writing for 'Rh Positive'; and red/white writing for 'Rh Negative' – in strips on backing paper.
OTHER INFORMATION	These labels were used for labelling blood donations. Each label has a section 'BLOOD DRAWN' that had the date that the donation was taken that would have been stamped onto the label. The labels also have the blood centre location identified as S.W.BLOOD TRANSFUSION CENTRE BRISTOL. Note: Each label comprises a large and two smaller versions of the label – the larger label was used for labelling the anticoagulated blood pack whilst the smaller labels were attached to attached satellite packs.
